SCC requires an active commitment to, and accountability for HSE from all employees and contractors. SCC Line Management has a Leadership role in the communication and implementation of, and ensuring compliance with, HSE Policy, HSE Management System & HSE Procedures.

In this endeavor, SCC shall strive to be "Conscious of its responsibility towards creating, conserving, protecting and ascertaining a clean environment through prevention of pollution for sustainable development and protect the health & safety of all its associated workforce, ensuring thereby a safe, healthy and accident free work place".
